Dear Texas All-State Treble Choir Member,

Congratulations on your amazing accomplishment! Because of your hard work, dedication, and perseverance, you will always be able to say with pride, "I was a member of the Texas All State Choir." You will have the mountaintop musical experience of a lifetime at TMEA! Your conductor will be Dr. Julie Yu-Oppenheim, from Kansas State University, and your section leaders will be some of the finest high school choral directors in Texas.

As a member of an All-State organization, you will have several responsibilities. Please carefully read the enclosed information as you prepare for your upcoming trip to San Antonio, February 12-15, 2020.

Before you come...

In order to complete your registration for the All-State Choir, you will need to bring the Code of Conduct and Medical Release forms, completed and signed as indicated on the letter you received from Mr. Floyd when you logged in. Your director has received your All State Code and password, unique to you, with which you should already have logged in as an All State Student at <u>www.tmea.org</u>. **You cannot register without completed forms**. Your participation will be suspended until all forms are completed. You mustn't delay this process! The medical form requires a notification, and this takes some time and a little effort on your part to complete.

Bring original copies of all of your music. Do not bring photocopies!

TASKS to be completed before you leave:

Number all measures before you get to San Antonio!

Check www.TMEA.org for divisi and performance notes for the new music. You must know your Area (A-H), since part and divisi assignments are based on this information. Write in solfege and mark your music according to Dr. Yu's sample scores, available as PDF's on the website and from your director. Your music WILL be checked for COMPLETION of this task at your first sectional rehearsal! Learn all of your new music before you arrive in San Antonio!

- Secure and bring a NEW clean, black folder for your music, and DON'T FORGET A PENCIL!
- Your music should already be hole-punched and arranged in your binder when you arrive.
- Bring \$5 cash. We will be collecting a \$5 donation during sectionals for appreciation gifts for our conductor and accompanist.
- Bring a water bottle. Stay hydrated, stay rested, stay healthy.

What to Pack:

Planning and good judgment should be used when selecting clothes to be worn during rehearsals and convention activities. Be prepared for cold and/or rainy weather. Wear acceptable school appropriate clothes to rehearsals. You must wear your school's formal choir uniform for performances. Don't forget shoes, socks, ties and cummerbunds etc. that accompany that uniform. This concert will be a memorable performance for you and your family.
